Dr. Rajesh Dhakal is a Professor of Structural and Earthquake Engineering at University of Canterbury in New Zealand, where he is also a Chartered Professional Engineer. He obtained his PhD from the University of Tokyo in 2000. Prof. Dhakal research interests lie in Seismic performance and design of RC structures, and Seismic loss minimization in buildings. Prof. Dhakal has supervised more than 50 postgraduate students and authored more than 450 papers. He is a recipient of 2007 Ivan Skinner Award for advancement of earthquake engineering research in New Zealand. Prof. Dhakal is the President of the International Association of SPONSE (Seismic Performance of Non-Structural Elements) and he has been the Chief Editor of the Bulletin of the New Zealand Society for Earthquake Engineering. He has also served as an Associate Editor of the ASCE Journal of Structural Engineering for six years.
